The annual, first semi-annual and first monthly tuition payments for 2017-2018 are due in June 2017. The remaining monthly tuition payments will be due in September through May. The second semi-annual payment is due in January 2018. The portion equal to the June monthly payment serves as a non-refundable deposit to reserve classroom placement.

St. Eugene's School uses FACTS Tuition Management Company to manage our tuition payment program. All families must enroll in FACTS. School fees, the capital replacement surcharge, the parish commitment, daycare, field trips and other incidentals are also paid through FACTS. Returning families will be automatically re-enrolled with FACTS according with the payment plan selected during the 2017 – 2018 re-enrollment. Bank or credit account information may be updated by logging onto your FACTS account. New families will set up FACTS accounts through the FACTS portal on our school website

A late fee of \$10.00 will be charged on past-due accounts each month, and there is a \$15.00 charge on returned checks.

CAPITAL REPLACEMENT AND MAJOR REPAIR SURCHARGE

A **\$200 surcharge** will be assessed in August when no tuition is due. This charge will help offset the significant cost of maintaining and repairing our school and grounds.

SCRIP COMMITMENT

The Scrip requirement for 2017-2018 is **\$250 profit** to the school and covers revenue received from May 16, 2017 to May 15, 2018.

Families that exceed the requirement will earn tuition credit equal to half their profit over \$250. Families that make a sincere effort but bring in less than \$250 profit will be charged the difference. Families that do not participate in Scrip will be charged \$300.

PEP HOURS

Each family is required to complete **24 parent volunteer hours** each year, at least 14 of which must be in designated areas, and every family is required to sign up to volunteer for at least one of our major fundraisers – Walk-a-thon, Christmas Fair, Crab Feed and Spring Barbecue. In order to qualify for “A” or “B” tuition the following year the volunteer hour requirement must be met. Please see the tuition and PEP policies for further clarification.

FUND-RAISING

The mandatory fund-raising commitment of **\$200 per family** may be met with the following options:

- 1) Buy or sell \$200 in raffle tickets for the Disneyland Vacation drawing at the Spring BBQ.
- 2) Increase your Scrip profit commitment by \$200.
- 3) Make a donation of \$200 – all in July or \$20 each month.

The mandatory fund-raising commitment covers only part of the funds the PTO raises for our school, so your support is needed for other fundraisers too.
