

P.E.P. – PARENT ENCOURAGED PARTICIPATION PROGRAM (SERVICE HOURS)
P.E.P. HOURS REQUIREMENT

The purpose of parent hours is to provide needed help, to build community and to model Christian service. Each family is required to give a minimum of 24 parent hours per school year. Ten of the 24 hours must be in areas of designated needs, and the remaining 14 hours may be in those or any general non-designated service areas.
